

## **Covid Protocols**

The health and safety of our guests and staff is our top priority. We are committed to ensuring that you have an exceptional experience, with confidence in the policies and procedures designed for a safe environment for all. Below are the Covid protocols for **Day at the Ranch** which are subject to change.

All guests 12 and older will be required to show proof of being <u>fully</u> vaccinated<sup>\*</sup> <u>OR</u> proof of a negative lab-based Covid-19 PCR or Antigen test within 72 hours of the date of the event at check-in. Kids between 5 and 11 will need proof of a negative lab-based Covid-19 PCR or Antigen test within 72 hours of the date of the event at check-in.

- If showing proof of negative test, the earliest testing date that will be valid is Thursday, November 11th.
  - Tests must be PCR or Antigen and results need to be lab-based. <u>Results from</u> <u>at-home test kits will not be accepted.</u>

- Testing will <u>not</u> be available at the event.
- If showing proof of vaccination, you may bring your actual card, show a photo of the front <u>and</u> back, or show your Digital Vaccination Record.
  - Digital Vaccination Records must be issued by California Department of Public Health (CDPH) or an approved company (e.g., Healthvana, Carbon Health, CommonPass, CLEAR Health Pass, VaxYes)
  - People who were vaccinated in California can get a free digital COVID-19 Vaccination Record at: <u>https://myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov/</u>
- During the event, masks are not required, but recommended.
- Failing to comply with the above guidelines will result in not being admitted to the event.

\*According to the CDC, you are fully vaccinated 2 weeks after your second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine.
